


FULTON STREET PROPOSED SITE PLAN








Upcoming Landing Closures










Closure Details

- Starting **today (Monday, April 5)**, the DUMBO (and South Williamsburg) ferry landings will be closed for 8-10 weeks
- The ER and SB routes will bypass DUMBO during this time
- Construction will take place Monday Friday from 7 AM 3:30 PM
- Alternate transit options during construction:
 - B25 bus on Old Fulton St & Elizabeth Pl
 - A/C train at High Street
 - 2/3 train at Clark Street
 - Citibike on Old Fulton St
 - Walk 20 minutes to Pier 6-Atlantic Ave. NYC Ferry







New Landing Benefits

- Allow Bargemusic easy waterside access
- Improve ADA accessibility
 - The new barge will allow for both slips to operate with electric bow loaders, ensuring that anyone with a wheelchair, stroller, bike, cane, etc. has safe access to the ferry and the landing
- Improve ferry operations
 - Due to currents in the East River, docking is often not feasible at land-facing slips, creating a bottleneck
 - Re-orienting the barge will provide safe docking for the ferry vessels
